CHRISTIAN COMEDY

PURPOSE: To encourage young men and women to express their spiritual experiences and insight using clean, Christian comedy.

PROCESS

Each participant (or church coordinator) will:

- Be certain that youths are registered for this event no later than the registration deadline.
- Be at the assigned room for the start of the event.
- Be certain that at least one adult volunteer is provided if the congregation has <u>any</u> youths participating in this event. The church coordinator is responsible for this.

The Event Coordinator will:

- Assume responsibility for the Mid-West LTC Christian comedy event, and be certain that the room set up is adequate.
- Conduct an evaluators meeting before the event.
- Provide adult volunteers to serve as "room emcee" for each event room. MWLTC organizers will assist to determine how many emcees are needed.
- Be certain that room assignments for youths have been made and posted. MWLTC organizers will assist with this.
- Report results and provide critique sheets to the Awards Committee.

GUIDELINES

Participant Eligibility:

- This event is available to any registered youth.
- Male and Female youths will deliver their Christian comedy in the same venue.
- There are two grade levels in this event: Grades 3-6 and Grades 7-12.
- Christian comedy is a solo event and each participant shall only perform once.
- Each participant must first rehearse his/her routine before their Church Coordinator to check for any unsavory jokes or material.

CONDUCTING THE EVENT

- There are separate divisions for grades 3-6 and grades 7-12.
- Microphones will be provided and set up prior to the event.
- Spectators may enter and/or leave the room between comedy performances. Door monitors will not allow entrances and exits during a youth's performance.

Christian Comedy:

- Content: Christian Comedy is a chance for youth to use humor to connect with an audience. With that in mind, and in respect to the current year's theme, use the Christian comedy to reflect GOD's WORD, and your spiritual life, experiences, and point of view.
- *Time:* The Christian comedy must be between:
 - Two to three minutes for Grades 3-6,
 - Three to five minutes for Grades 7-12.
- *Delivery:* This event is for clean Christian comedy. Christian comedy is performed enthusiastically, rather than just read. For that purpose, the tone of voice, facial expression, body mannerisms, etc. can enhance the delivery.
- *Memorization:* Memorization is encouraged, as it will help with the delivery, but not required.
- Props and Audible Aids: Props, instrumental sound tracks, and sound effect
 accompanied tracks are permitted, but not necessary. Props and/or tracks are to
 be used as they fit into the act. Do not allow these aids to be a distraction.
- *Instruments*: Instruments are allowed if they are part of your comedy act. Your ability (or inability) to play the instrument will not affect your score.
